Aim of the game is to retrace our knowledge about energy and remind ourselves on what ways can we save energy and reduce greenhouse gasses.

Instructions: The game can be played by unlimited number of players. To play, you need a dice and figurines. First, put your figurines on start and to begin the game you must roll 6. The winner of the game is the one who steps on goal first. Good luck!



1. You washed laundry today and instead of putting it in dryer, you took it outside and left it to dry on sun. Go to field number 2.
2. Mom sent your older brother to buy some bread. He wanted to go with a car, but you told him that he should, for his and environments sake, use his bike. Go 3 fields forward.
3. You have the capability to use light from the solar collectors in your house, but you still use the electric net that your parents are paying for. Miss 2 throws.
4. You realized that showering saves much more water than bathing. As a reward, choose a player that you want to return back to start.
5. You've collected plenty of junk at home. Instead of selecting it in proper containers, you decided to burn it. Go 7 fields backwards.
6. You found a tank with a sign of a radioactive waste on it. Despite the warning you're peeking in it. Game's over for you.
7. This smiley is happy because you taught him to make compost and reduce his waste for 30%. As a reward go 7 fields forward.
8. You were on a class excursion in Netherlands- the land of windmills and tulips. You decided to cheer your class and prepared many interesting facts about windmills. Go 5 fields forward.
9. Take a card and answer the question. If your answer is correct, roll a dice once more, if not, miss one toss.
10. You stepped on a very windy place. Wind blew you 9 fields behind.
11. If you can name non-renewable sources of energy to other players, you can roll a dice one more time.
12. You've noticed that your neighbour isn't sorting his waste and he puts all the waste in one bin. You decided to tell him how that isn't good. With yourself as an example, you showed him how to sort his waste. As a reward go to the field 17.
13. On a biology class teacher was explaining what freons are. You weren't paying attention so you don't know that those are the harmful gasses that destroy earth's ozone layer. Go 5 fields back.
14. Even though you know that motorcycles belch harmful gases that infest environment, you ride them all the time. Miss a throw.
15. You left your graffiti creations on a tree in woods. Go 6 fields backward.

16. You turn off the lights when no one is in the room. Go to field 18.
18. Take a card. If your answer is correct, go on goal!
19. Take a card with questions. If you answer correctly, roll a dice one more time, if not, wait one throw.
20. Mom sent you to store. Instead of buying an economy light bulb, you bought the regular one and bought yourself an ice cream with change. Miss a throw.
